

## **Field and Facilities Helpful Hints**

- Base anchors are located 4" toward home plate from tassel. If you need help finding them call 972-955-7330.
  - The tassels are there to mark the base anchors, please do not pull them out of the fields.
  - Please do not kick, push or move clay into the grass.
  - Please report any issues you have with fields, equipment or facilities on the field issue page of the FMYSA website. Do not make repairs.
  - Do not climb any fencing – if fields are locked please call field assistance line – 972-955-7330
  - Smoking is allowed in the parking lot **only** in all Flower Mound parks
  - Practices end at 8:30 p.m., gates are closed and locked promptly at 9:00 p.m. the lights are left on for 15 minutes extra to gather equipment and to get to your car. Sundays practices end at 9:00 p.m. light go out at 9:00 p.m. except parking, parking lights will go out and gates will be locked at 9:15 p.m.
  - Please continue to keep the dugouts clean after you use the facilities, also ask the parents to clean up the bleachers as they have become an issue. The dugouts have been staying very clean recently, solely because of your efforts.
  - All broken equipment can be replaced by calling 972-955-7330, the broken equipment must be returned.
  - All coaches must have a dig out tool and can be purchased at the concession stand. Please don't remove the facilities and tournament directors' tools from the carts. Call Field assistance number for purchase of balls – 972-955-7330.
  - Please stop the boys from digging holes in the outfield, if you see a boy looking down at the grass during games or practice, most likely they are looking at a hole and will participate in its expansion. (rec and select).
  - Field assistance phone number is on all score tables and buildings at Bakersfield. The Facilities Director is always available to support you and your efforts.
  - Please follow the signs at all parks. Walking around field 1 will put you in direct contact with wild life, they will see you before you see them. (Coyotes, venomous snakes, Bobcats, Rats, Bees, possibly wild Pigs and Cow!!!)

- If any field is prepped for a game (batters boxes and foul lines are new) do not practice on this field. There is a weekly document on the FMYSA website which will show the

fields that are scheduled for games and their times. This document may not be completely accurate, as rescheduled games may not make it on the list. You can verify whether the fields are scheduled for games by calling 972-955-7330.

- Please Do Not use any fencing at any field for soft toss batting practice, use the soft toss nets.
- Tarps in the dugouts are to be used by FMYSA directors only.
- Please try to pay attention to the siblings of your team members. They can get bored and go to find things to do. We have sidewalk chalk in the office for kids to use. This helps stop the kids from breaking branches from trees and fence climbing, or going into the woods allowing direct contact with wild life etc..
